#### What you Do

- Submit your information contact us to receive your application package. We will need your resume, current 5 year driver's abstract and a criminal record check. We will review your application and if we have open opportunities and see a good fit we will then schedule an interview. If your interview is successful you will be invited to orientation.
- Attend orientation Orientation can be done at your own pace, depending on how quickly you want to get started. Orientation is paid at a flat rate of \$250.
- Get on the road We like all our trucks to do a minimum of 10,000 miles per month. Many of our trips have drivers away from home 3-5 days at a stretch.

We will work collaboratively with all Drivers to facilitate a plan that works with desired home time, your financial obligations and our customers' needs.

Stay safe - we expect you to operate your vehicle in a safe manner, following all company and Government rules and regulations. Safety bonuses are offered after 3 months and are paid out quarterly, if you have no tickets, infractions or accidents.

### What it takes to get started:

If you're interested in proceeding, here are the steps that need to be completed to get you onboard:

- · Application Email your application to findyourrightfit@landtran.com
- Complete the application we will need your up to date resume showing a minimum of 2 years class 1 Rocky mountains inclusive experience, a current 5 year commercial driver's abstract, a recent Criminal Record search, a copy of your Driver's License and the completed application form to proceed.
- •Truck specification requirements truck records are needed to proceed with insurance and licensing. We will need copies of the following:
  - o Bill of sale (lease agreement if financed), for your truck showing year, make and model of equipment
  - o Safety inspection for truck
  - o Maintenance records showing that truck has been properly maintained
  - o Company registration/incorporation letter
  - o Workers Compensation coverage letter
  - o Voided company cheque
  - o Photo of your truck from all four sides showing required equipment
  - o Your personal PPE (hard hat, reflective vest, safety glasses and steel-toe boots (above the ankle)
- ·Pre-employment requirements we will check your references, schedule you for a drug and alcohol test, and an on-road evaluation.
- ·Sign contract once everything has been received and reviewed, you will sign the company driver contract, agreeing to the company rules and regulations, compensation plan, and commitments.

#### Welcome to the Landtran TL family!

You must have all the following equipment on your truck prior to your employment start date:

- 30 straps (4 inch with D ring)
- 12 chains (grade 70) 3/8" 20 feet long
- 12 binders (ratchet)
- Tarps (sufficient for tridem or Super B as applicable)
- Headache rack
- Your personal PPE (hard hat, reflective vest, safety glasses and steel-toe boots (above the ankle))

You must, after your 90-day probation period, also have an over dimensional kit consisting of:

- · 6 fifty-foot long four-inch belts with D-ring
- · 25-foot tape measure
- 100-foot tape measure
- 8 flags
- Over Dimensional signs (Oversize and D-Sign)
- Over Dimensional lights magnetic (2 red & 2 amber) with extra batteries
- · Magnetic beacon(s) for rear of load
- · Wide load mirrors



# Costs and revenues you can expect as an Owner Operator

These are some typical startup costs, ongoing operations costs, and revenue structure, so you know what to expect. Cost and revenue will vary based on where you are located, suppliers in the area, and your personal choices.

#### STARTUP COSTS (IF APPLICABLE)

· Owner Operators must have all equipment (straps, chains, tarps etc.) as per the minimum equipment list.

#### CONTINENTAL CARTAGE SUPPLIES/PAYS FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- · Continental Cartage supplies the decals
- · Continental Cartage supplies fuel cards for Shell, Chevron, Petropass, Esso as well as BC Ferries card and a DIA scale card.
- · Continental Cartage pays all tolls and weigh scales and border crossings.
- · Continental Cartage pays the cost of licence plates.
- · Continental Cartage pays the cost of insurance.

#### **HOLDBACK**

· There is a \$5000 hold back which is deducted at \$250 per month for 20 months.

#### **ONGOING OPERATION COSTS FOR OWNER OPERATORS**

- · Vehicle maintenance
- · Travel expenses
- · Owner operators pay their own fuel Continental Cartage provides a fuel rebate (\*Please see contract for details)

#### REVENUE

- · All documented work completed will be paid out based on a 30-day processing hold back. For example, work completed July 1-31 will be paid out August 28. Mid-month advances will be paid on the 15th of each month according to the terms of the contract.
- · Safety Bonuses will be paid out quarterly and will begin accumulation immediately. They will be paid to the operator by the end of the 4th month. (\*Please see contract for conditions)
- · We would like all Owner Operators to do a minimum of 10,000 miles per month.

#### **BENEFITS**

· As an Owner Operator, you are eligible to enroll in the medical and dental plan offered through Manulife from Day 1.



#### BY THE MILE CONTRACT

Rates range from \$1.38 - \$1.60 per mile depending on the destination and trailer size.

Plus paid plates (valued at 7c per mile),

Paid insurance (valued at 7c per mile),

Fuel rebate fluctuates weekly as per FCAC added to mileage\*

IE: Tridems - 33.9% Super B - 40% as of 08/13/19

**Safety Bonus - \$0.02** after 3 months (paid out quarterly based on no tickets or infractions)

In Addition:

Tarping - \$200 per trip

Loading/Unloading Incentive - \$70 per trip (\$35 Loading - \$35 Unloading)

**\$50** toward cellphone bill monthly

Orientation: - \$250

#### BY THE MILE CONTRACT

Our Owner Operators have the potential to average just over 12,500 miles per month. We would like for all of our trucks to do a minimum of 10,000 miles per month and home time is totally your choice. We request you provide us with one week's notice and our dispatchers will do their best to get you home when requested.

After **three months** of service, you are eligible to enroll in our medical and dental benefit program.

We are primarily a flat deck company, so if it fits on a deck then we will haul it.

Once references have been checked, we then schedule you for a Drug/Alcohol test, followed by an on-road evaluation. Once everything is completed and you have met all requirements, we arrange a driver orientation in Acheson, Alberta, which takes about 2 to 3 days.
